



Blue Faery goes to Washington--again!

This bill would change the Public Health Service Act "to revise and extend the program for viral hepatitis surveillance, education and testing in order to prevent deaths from chronic liver diseases and liver cancer." The passage of this bill would ensure all Baby Boomers would be tested for Hepatitis C, a recommendation made by the CDC more than a year ago in order to stop the rise of liver cancer in the United States.

My life as a parent started in 1994 when my eight-year-old sister Adrienne visited me for Christmas. At 22-years-old, I had little money or job stability, but it never occurred to me to say no.


Blue Faery highlights HCC clinical trials
