Known as the Liver Shiver, the event borrows the concept of the "Polar Bear" plunge, as participants line up on Folly Beach to charge into the Atlantic Ocean in late January. Liver Shiver sells t-shirts and accepts cash donations with the goal of raising money for cancer.

This year, Blue Faery was honored to become the recipient of Liver Shiver's fundraising efforts. Gene and the rest of Liver Shiver's supporters selected Blue Faery because they were very moved by Adrienne's story. Gene started Liver Shiver in honor of his father-in-law who continues to fight liver cancer to this day.
